ESIC Hospital, Manesar (ISO: 9001:2015 certified), is part of the Employees' State Insurance Corporation's, (Ministry of Labour, Government of India) vast network of hospitals (36 hospitals) across the country. Directly providing the best medical facilities available under one roof with a dedicated and compassionate team of doctors, nurses and paramedics. This hospital is commissioned on 28/03/2011 as a 100 beds facility. It covers (3,18,851IPs & families of Manesar, Gurgaon, Rewari, and Dharuhera.Total 06 Dispensaries are attached with the hospital. These are Khogaon(Manesar), New Manesar, Binolla, Bawal, Dharuhera & Narnaul. In addition to it patients also come from adjoining areas like Bhiwadi, Rewari , Jhajjar and Mahendragarh .

ACCESSIBILITY :

Located at Sector-03, IMT Manesar, District, Gurugram, Haryana. Hospital is well connected by road transportation (Gurugaman Buses and auto rikshaw) with Delhi-Jaipur National Highway 8 at IMT Chowk which is just 2K.M. from the hospital. The nearest railway station is Gurgaon.

Directional signboards for various Departments and facilities are displayed at the Main entrance as well as in the Main O.P.D. Block and other strategic locations throughout the Hospital.

Registration and Admission Counters and a dedicated Enquiry Counter (MAY I HELP YOU Desk) is located at centralized location in the Hospital near the Emergency Department.

ADMINISTRATION:

The Hospital is managed by a well trained and experienced team headed by the Medical Superintendent. There is one Assistant Medical Superintendent to look after the day-to-day work of the Hospital. The Medical Superintendent is also assisted by an Assistant Nursing Superintendent, a Deputy Director (Administration) and Deputy Director (Finance). The functioning of each Specialty is being looked-after by the concerned Head of the Department.

HOSPITAL INFRASTRUCTURE:

Basement:

Medical Stores, Non-Medical store, Telephone Exchange Maintenance Department, Fire station pumping room, Diesel Generator set, Electricity transformers section, Housekeeping office and Parking for hospital staff is located at basement.

Ground Floor:

Accident and Emergency Department, Main OPD Registration Counter, Help-Desk, Canteen, Kitchen, Emergency Plaster Room, Pharmacy store-cum-distribution counter, Laundry, C.S.S.D., Mortuary, Oxygen Manifold Room, BMW and General waste collection room, CCTV monitoring cum public address system control room, Security Cabin, Integrated Counseling and Testing Centre for HIV/AIDS, Ambulance staff retiring room and ESIC branch office is located at ground floor.

Operation theatre complex including pre and post-operative area, Medicine ward, Male Surgery Ward, Medical Record Room, Doctors common room, SST Room.

Fourth Floor:

All administrative offices are at fourth floor which includes offices of Medical Superintendent, Assistant Medical Superintendent, Deputy Director Administration, Deputy Director Finance, Administrative staff sections and PA to MS. Conference hall is located adjoining the administrative block.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Number of Beds: Sanctioned 100 (Fully Operational).

All Clinical staff members (Doctors, Nurses, Paramedical)wear white apron, uniform and name badge.

STANDARDS FOR SERVICE :

This is a general hospital exclusively meant for ESI card holders (Insured Persons and their dependents).

However, Accident and Emergency department is working 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and 365 days a year for IP, their families as well as general public.

It is our endeavor to provide prompt and courteous attention and care to all our beneficiaries.

ACCIDENT AND EMERGENCY SERVICES:

Timings:- 24 Hours x 7 (all 365 days).

Number of beds: 10 (Fully operational)

Emergency ECG, X-ray and Plaster facility is available within the Emergency block.

Casualty Medical Officer and Resident doctors are available round the clock.

Duty Doctor along with Resident is available round the clock in Major specialties viz, Medicine, Surgery, Orthopedics, Pulmonary Medicine, Anesthesia, Pediatrics, Gynecology & Obstetrics).

Specialists in various specialties are available from 9 AM to 4 PM and, thereafter, on-Call.

Emergency cases are promptly attended on high priority basis.

In all serious cases, treatment/management gets priority over paper work like registration of medico-legal formalities.

Assistance is available at the entrance of Emergency Department for patients as well as their attendants.

Helpline Number is functional round the clock.

Police officers respond promptly round the clock to help C.M.O. in medico-legal cases to maintain law and order within the campus.

OUT PATIENT DEPARTMENTS:

Registration Timings:

8 A.M. to 12:30 P.M. (Monday to Friday)

8 A.M. to 11-30 A.M.(Saturdays)

OPD of all the departments are situated at first and second floor.

Every out-patient seeking treatment at the hospital is registered on production of a referral cum treatment slip issued by respective dispensary with proper insurance number for examination, investigation and treatment by the concerned specialty.

Online appointment with specific doctor/O.P.D. can be booked through online / App.

Sufficient number of benches is provided outside every room in O.P.D. and all waiting areas of the hospital.

All disciplines in OPD have a separate nursing orderly to help the patients for sorting out investigation reports and to guide them to their respective rooms.

Name of attending doctor is displayed outside each room in O.P.D.

Name of the discipline is displayed on a large board within O.P.D.

Senior Citizens are provided registration on priority basis through a separate queue.

Immunizations is done on every Wednesday in room no 216.

Family Welfare services - like contraceptive, IUD and sterilization services are provided daily to promote small family norms. These facilities are open to all citizens.

Space for yoga is located at the 2nd floor, providing facilities for staff and beneficiaries on all working days. Yoga instructor conducts yoga therapy on OPD basis and also at indoor department for admitted patients.

PHYSIOTHERAPY & OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY:

Is available everyday under the supervision of trained Occupational therapist and Physiotherapist for both OPD and IPD patients .

MEDICAL RECORD DEPARTMENT:

Medical Record Department provides services regarding registration, admission and discharges. It also provides services related to registration of birth and death for new born babies born in ,and deaths occurring in the hospital .

Births and deaths in the hospital are reported online to PHC authorities.

It also coordinates with local health authorities in regard to censes related to national health programmes.

SECURITY ARRANGEMENTS:

Various security guards from private agency are stationed at crucial points within the hospital campus.

A Senior Security Officer is supervising the security arrangement of the Hospital, besides these, senior doctors take round of the hospital after duty hours.

For monitoring of Hospital Infection a Hospital Infection Control Committee has been set up.

Training

In order to upgrade the skills of various categories of staff, periodic training programmes are undertaken.

Clinical meetings are conducted from time to time.

Periodic lectures on AIDS awareness as well as other prevalent diseases are held.

Wheel chairs and Stretchers are available at the gate of Emergency O.P.D. as well as in wards for transportation of patients.

Six Lifts are available in the Hospital Block.

Two Ambulances are available for transfer of patients seeking referral to other hospitals round the clock and to sending the samples to ESICH&MC, Faridabad, Haryana and other empanelled diagnostic centres to avoid unnecessary hustle of patients to these locations for sample collection.

There are three stand-by generators to cater to emergency services in case of failure of electric supply.

6 Cold drinking water through R.O. Systems is available at various locations.

Canteen facilities for attendants of the patients and staff are available on the ground floor of the building. Various food items are provided at reasonable cost.

Air-Conditioned mortuary is available for keeping dead bodies.

Recently an Oxygen Plant is established with the help of Maruti Suzuki Pvt. Limited under the C.S.R. initiative.

Well illuminated & air-conditioned waiting areas for patients are available at Dept. of Casualty, O.P.D., Registration Counter, etc.
